Frequently Asked Questions

What are the dates and times?

Summer Camp will run from **July 8th to July 26th**. Classes will take place **Monday – Friday** from **9AM – 3PM**. See below for specific dates and weekly themes.

Session 1: STEAM Week: Monday, July 8 – Friday, July 12, 2023

Session 2: Community Week: Monday, July 15 – Friday, July 19, 2023

Session 3: Artivism Week: Monday, July 22 – Friday, July 26, 2023

Each session includes a morning team building activity, dance and movement sessions, student exhibitions and more! Note: Summer Camp Culmination will take place **July 28th**, **2024** from **2PM – 4PM**.

What ages can attend Summer Camp?

This summer camp is open for students ages 6-15. Classes are divided between two groups. Students from 6-10 years old are placed in Group A, students from 11-15 years old are placed in Group B.

What is the cost of Summer Camp?

Summer Camp Fees are charged per participant, per week.

Non-Members: \$250.00 Members: \$225.00

How do I pay?

Our payment portal can be accessed through our Summer Camp Webpage. Payment links are available for each age group, for each week. We accept debit and credit cards.

You may also pay in person; our museum lobby hours are Wednesday – Sunday from 11am – 6pm. Our VSA staff can process cash, debit/credit cards.

Members, you must sign in for your 10% discount to be applied at checkout.

How do I complete registration?

You will receive a confirmation e-mail once you have submitted your payment. This email will prompt you to complete our **Registration and Emergency Contact Form**. This form **must be submitted by June 24**th, **2024** to verify attendance.

I paid and registered my student(s), what now?

Summer Camp Orientation Packets will be sent out **Friday**, **June 28**th, **2024**. These packets will include our camp schedule, class themes and our Photo Release Form. We ask that you review materials in this packet before your first day of Camp.

Photo Release Forms must be completed for each student and can be submitted via email or in person on your first day of camp.

When is the culmination event?

We love to celebrate the artistic achievements of your camper! Our Summer Camp Culmination will take place **July 28th**, **2024** from **2PM – 4PM**. We will send out an RSVP email a week before the end of camp to confirm your attendance and party count.

Are absences allowed?

We want to respect the time and effort put in by our teaching artists, interns, and students. Your student will begin exploring materials or engaging in artistic discussions on their first day of camp. If they miss more than one day, they may miss out on the full experience of art camp.

It's summer vacation and life can throw unexpected events on the busiest of days. We understand. Student absences are allowed but are limited to two days.
